

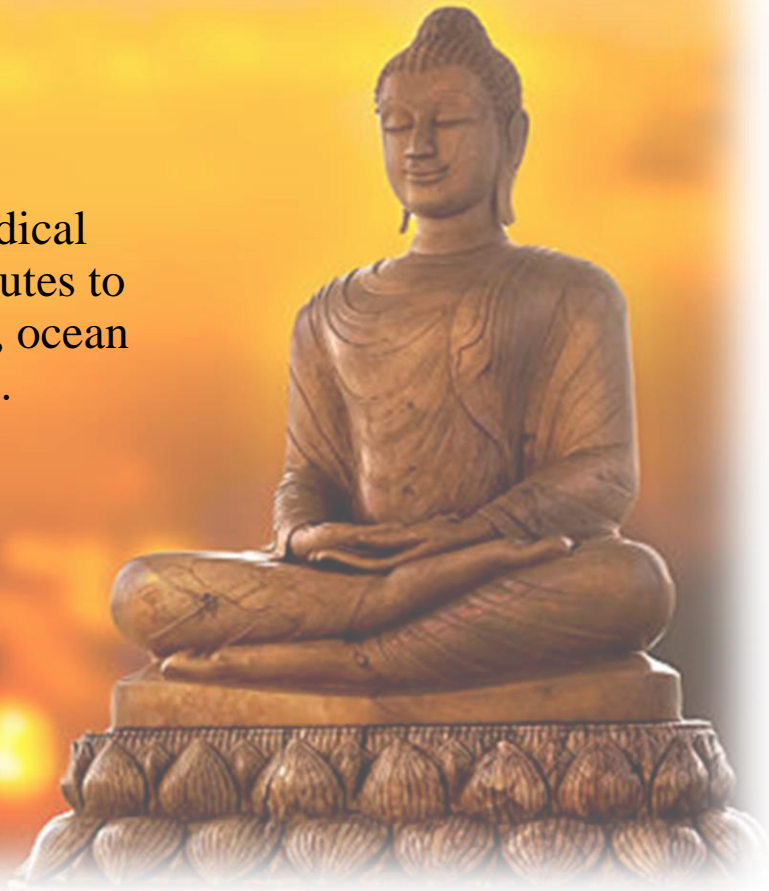

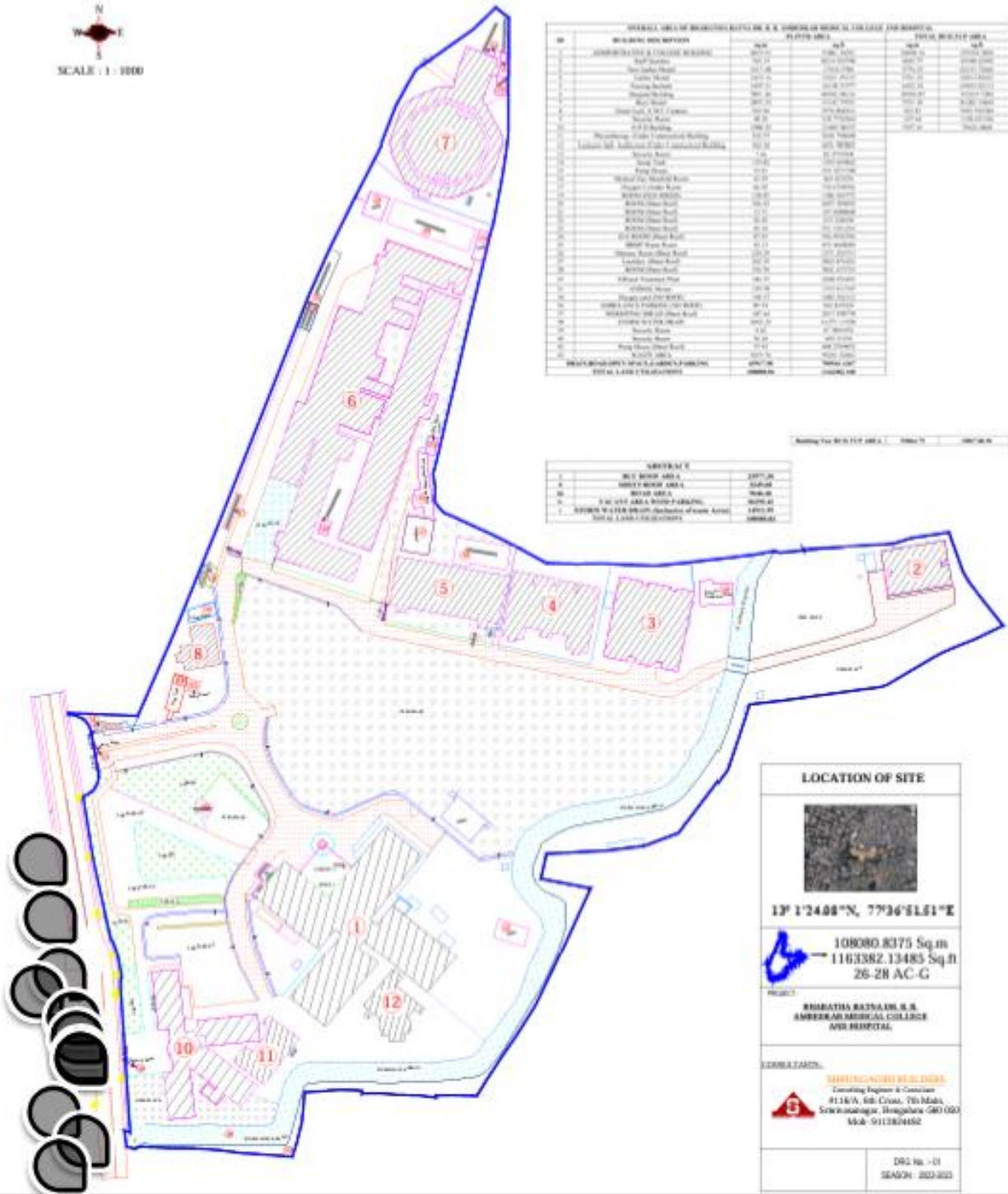

OUR COLLEGE TODAY



In May 1987 the college moved to its own spacious building at Kadugondanahalli, a suburb in the North Bangalore. Designed and built to meet architectural and utilitarian considerations, the Ambedkar Medical College Campus is a self-contained unit. The hostels for men and women students and the 767 bed hospital make it a full-fledged campus fully complying with the norms of the National Medical Council of India.

There is a total intake of 150 students per academic year making the present student strength of the college is more than 750.

The practice of medicine and surgery is more an art rather than mere science. To enable the medicos get the expert bedside teaching, AMC exercises enormous care in selecting the teaching staff. The heads of almost all the departments are experts in different fields of their speciality. In fact the teaching staff is a judicious blend of experience and young talent.

The Ambedkar Medical College is not contented with merely providing minimal infrastructural facilities necessary to get recognition from the National Medical Council of India or affiliation from the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences. Though the intake of the College is limited to 150 students per annum, each of the 8 audio-visual lecture halls in the college is built to seat two hundred students. Rather spacious demonstration rooms and laboratories are attached to each one of the pre-and para-clinical departments. Infact, the Anatomy Dissection Hall is so roomy that it can accommodate three hundred students at a time.

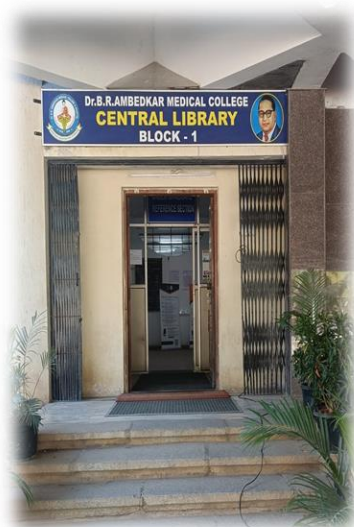
The pathology Department has been maintaining a museum with over a five hundred specimens. The Orthopaedics department also has special diagnostic equipment's and full-fledged physiotherapy section. The Radiology department is equipped with high end machinery catering to investigations such as ultrasonography, CT scan, MRI Etc. Every department in the college keeps itself pre-occupied with organising umpteen number of seminars, lectures, CMEs and Conferences ensuring that the faculty remain updated and in par with the latest advances at any given time.

Post-graduate courses have been started in 19 disciplines during this year.

THE CENTRAL AND DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARIES.

The well stocked central library has over 19955 books on various subjects ,116 journals of which 61 are foreign and 55 are Indian .We keep adding new titles and revised editions to the library every year. Apart from the ever-growing and reference volumes the library subscribes to a good number of specialised journals of repute. Keeping in pace with the growing technology our college also has access to Helinet and digital learning methods enabling students to gain knowledge from the ever-growing technological era.

The Central Library works from 8:30 am to 9:00 pm., Monday through Friday and on Saturday it works from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm., It is closed on Sunday and State Holidays. Apart from the central Library every department maintains its own specialised library. These Libraries, in addition to the volumes on the concerned specialities, maintain specialised journals and magazines also.



THE FORENSIC DEPARTMENT

The forensic department in our college is ranked as one of the top in conducting postmortems covering over 27 jurisdiction police stations in the north and northeast Bangalore. The department of forensic medicine conducts over 900 postmortems annually which enable the students to get good exposure to the practical aspects of this subject.

SKILL LAB

The **SKILLS LAB** at Dr BR Ambedkar Medical College Hospital is Newborn air-conditioned facility established to deliver expert multidisciplinary healthcare training. Since its inception in **2019**, students of all constituent colleges including medical, dental, nurses, allied health colleges have been trained at this centre supported by a strong team of instructors.

It boasts of varied standardized trainers, mannequins and simulators (110) Resuscitation airway man, Birthing mom, Little Anne QCPR (Adult QCPR), Little junior QCPR, Resusi junior QCPR, Enema catheter, Breast examination, Episiotomy trainer, Female pelvic trainer, Adult and Pediatrics I.V Arm, Baby Anne, New Born Anne, Spinal system solution, BSS KIT, Suture Tutor, AED, Heart SIM, Choking Charlie, Injection trainer, Skill guide

There are 5 Dedicated rooms for demonstrations of skills individually or in small groups 1 Review room and 1 debriefing rooms. All the mannequins are stored in fully air-conditioned rooms to increase the shelf life and maintain the best quality

Our skill lab is equipped to provide training in an array of techniques and procedures. The skill lab is used to give pre-clinical exposure to our students right from phase 2 and upwards. Obstetrics & gynaecological examination, Cancer screening procedures, Conducting vaginal delivery, Episiotomy training, Injection techniques- intradermal/intramuscular, Venipuncture, Visual acuity testing, CPR, Airway intubation, ECLS, Basic life support, advanced life support, Umbilical Cord Catheterisation, Newborn resuscitation are the procedures carried out in our skill lab to name a few. Our faculty at the skill lab are certified professionals and the ECLS, ACLS and NRP courses offered are

A Committee headed by the Principal and comprising senior professors, talented members of the staff, sports secretary and student representatives has been set up to monitor the various activities.

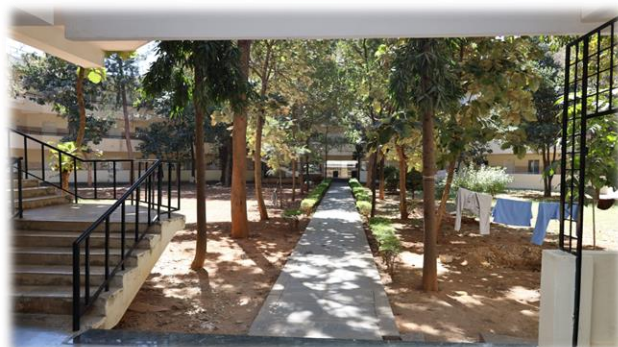
The college campus has spacious sports ground and materials for several outdoor sports activities and in-door games.

PHASE WISE TRAINING AND TIME DISTRIBUTION FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT THE PHASES OF MBBS

- University Examinations shall be held as under:
 - a) Phase-I shall be held at the end of Phase I training (in the 12th month of that training), in the subjects of Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry.
 - b) Phase-II examination shall be held at the end of Phase II training (12th month of that training), in the subjects of Pathology, Microbiology, and Pharmacology
 - c) Phase III Part 1 examination shall be held at the end of Phase III part 1 of training (12th month of that training) in the subjects of Community Medicine, Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, Ophthalmology and Otorhinolaryngology.
 - d) Phase III Part 2 / National Exit Test (NExT) as per NExT regulations- (Final Professional) examination shall be at the end of 17th / 18th month of that training, in the subjects of General Medicine, General Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Pediatrics, and allied subjects as per NExT Regulations.
- Criteria for passing in a subject: A candidate shall obtain a cumulative 50% marks in University conducted examination including theory and practical and not less than 40% separately in Theory and in Practical in order to be declared as passed in that subject. In subjects that have two papers, the learner must secure a minimum 40% marks in aggregate (both theory papers together).

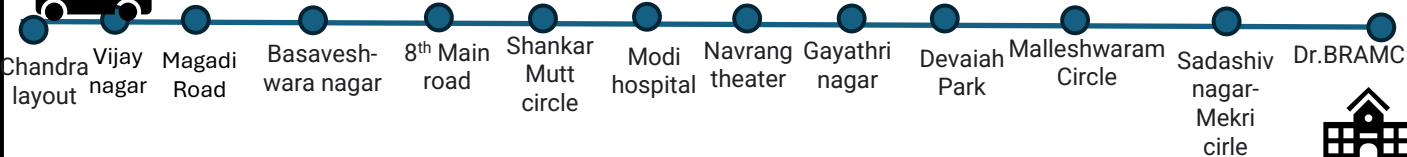
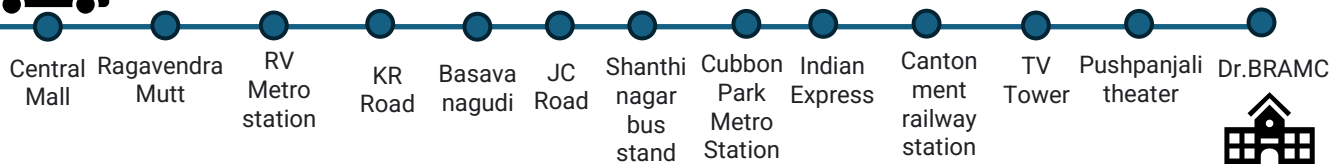
Supplementary examinations and declaration of results : This shall be processed by universities within 6-8 weeks from the date of declaration of the results of the main examination for every professional year, so that the candidates, who pass, can join the main batch for progression.

- If the student fails in the supplementary examination in phase 1 of MBBS, the student goes to the junior batch for teaching learning as well as for university examinations.
- There shall be no supplementary batches. If a candidate has not appeared for university examination (both theory and practical) for a subject then it shall not be counted as an attempt for that subject.
- Partial attendance in examination (only theory or only practical) in any subject shall be counted as an attempt. No more than four attempts shall be allowed for a candidate to pass the Phase 1 examination. The total period for successful completion of phase I course shall not exceed four (4) years.
- A learner shall not be entitled to graduate later than ten (10) years of her/his joining the first MBBS course (including continuous rotatory medical internship).

Attendance :

- There shall be a minimum of 75% attendance in theory and 80% attendance in practical /clinical for eligibility to appear for the examinations in that subject.
- In subjects that are taught in more than one phase - the learner must have 75% attendance in theory and 80% attendance in practical in each phase of instruction in that subject.
- There shall be a minimum of 75% attendance in AETCOM and minimum of 80% attendance in family visits under Family adoption programme. Each student shall adopt minimum 3 families/ households and preferably five families.
- If an examination comprises more than one subject (for e.g., General Surgery and allied branches), the candidate must have a minimum of 75% attendance in each subject including its allied branches, and 80% attendance in each clinical posting.
- Learners who do not have at least 75% attendance in the electives will not be eligible for the Third Professional - Part II examination/ NExT.

- **TRANSPORT:** The college provides bus facility to the student and faculty. The routes which the buses ply is as attached below.

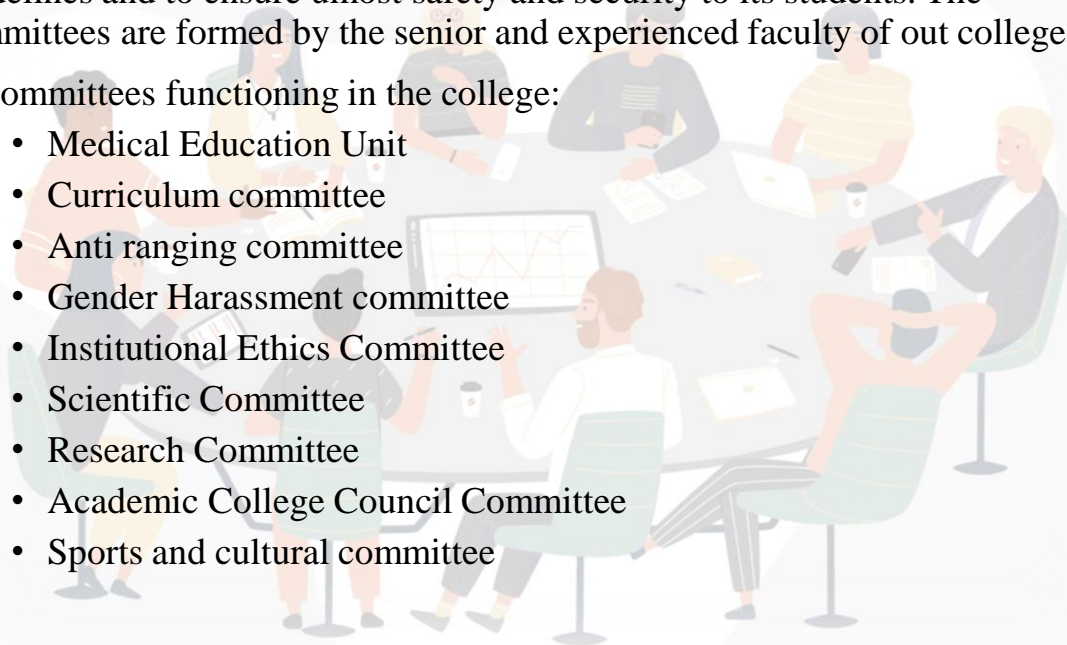
